Steve Baker was elected the Member of Parliament for Wycombe in 2010. He was appointed as Minister of State in the Northern Ireland Office in 2022.

Previously, Steve has served as Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State for Exiting the European Union, as well as Chair of the European Research Group and Deputy Chair of the COVID Recovery Group.

Steve's career began in the Royal Air Force as an engineer officer

working with Tornado, Jaguar and the Adour aero engine. He became a Chartered Engineer through the Royal Aeronautical Society and held a military airworthiness licence.

After his time with the RAF, he read for an MSc in Computer Science at Oxford University (St Cross College) and joined a specialist, entrepreneurial software firm as Head of Consulting and Product Manager before taking on various senior roles in business software.
